

**MEMORANDUM**  
**on Cooperation in the Field of Commercial Arbitration and**  
**Mediation between the Center of Arbitration and Mediation of**  
**the Chamber of Commerce and Industry of the Russian**  
**Federation and**  
**the Santiago Arbitration and Mediation Center of the Santiago**  
**Chamber of Commerce**

The Center of Arbitration and Mediation of the Chamber of Commerce and Industry of the Russian Federation and the Santiago Arbitration and Mediation Center of the Santiago Chamber of Commerce, hereinafter referred to as the “Parties”,

Aware of the role played by the cooperation between the business circles of the Russian Federation and the Republic of Chile and the importance of foreign investments for the economic development of both countries,

Considering the possibility of disputes, conflicts and differences as may arise from time to time in the commercial and investment relations between organizations and entrepreneurs of the Russian Federation and the Republic of Chile,


Being confident that arbitral proceedings (arbitration) and conciliatory procedures with the participation of a mediator (mediation) are in many cases the most effective method of resolving international commercial disputes,


Have agreed as follows:

1. The Parties shall cooperate in popularizing arbitral proceedings (arbitration) and conciliatory procedures with the participation of a mediator (mediation) and promote their use for resolution of disputes between Russian and Chilean participants of the foreign trade and economic activity.

2. The Parties have agreed to organize and hold joint seminars and conferences on dispute resolution issues for Russian and Chilean participants in the foreign trade and economic activity, promote publication in the print media of each country of the information about the activity of each other's institutions concerned with the settlement and resolution of disputes.
3. The Parties shall provide each other with information about their countries' legislation regulating arbitral proceedings (arbitration) and conciliatory procedures with the participation of a mediator and will exchange the texts of the relevant Rules of Procedure and Lists of Arbitrators and Mediators and also any other publication in this field that are of mutual interest.
4. The Parties shall assist each other in the selection of adequately qualified and experienced persons for inclusion of their candidatures in the Lists of Arbitrators and Mediators of the appropriate institutions of each Party.
5. The present Memorandum shall come into force as from the date of its signature and shall be effective until the date three months after which one of the Parties announces in writing its intention to terminate the present Memorandum.
